



NEW MEXICO NATIONAL GUARD MILITARY HALL OF HONOR

NOMINATION CRITERIA:

1. Exceptional military service of the individual, to include acts of heroic bravery, service, sacrifice and/or extraordinary leadership action(s). Military Rank will not be a factor.
2. Civilian public service and/or patriotic service above and beyond military service. Examples include civic, business, public service, volunteer activities or other pursuits.
3. An established New Mexico National Guard connection.
4. Nominees who served in the New Mexico National Guard must have separated or retired at least **five** years prior to the nomination.
5. Nominees shall be of good legal/ethical/moral character- military and civilian.

REQUIRED ITEMS

1. Documentation of military service. DD-214 (separation/discharge document or equivalent NGB 22) or other applicable official records (ie. decorations, certificates of achievements etc.).
2. Documentation of public and patriotic service. Examples are letters of recognition, news coverage, or personal testimony.
3. Documentation of New Mexico National Guard connection.
4. Photograph(s).
5. Contact information- phone number(s), email address(s), physical address for nominee (if living), or family (if deceased). If contact information is not known by nominator, provide explanation.
